

Blender Most Used Hotkeys & Shortcuts

Blender is a powerful 3D modelling and animation software with a wide range of keyboard shortcuts and hotkeys to help streamline your workflow. Here are some of the most commonly used shortcuts and hotkeys in Blender:

But before we begin please note down these 3 important shortforms:

LMB: Left Mouse Button

RMB: Right Mouse Button

MMB: Middle Mouse Button (Scroll Wheel)

General Hotkeys & Shortcuts in Bender:

1. **G:** Grab/Move
2. **R:** Rotate
3. **S:** Scale
4. **X, Y, Z:** Constrain movement along the X, Y, or Z-axis while transforming (e.g., GX for grabbing along the X-axis)
5. **A:** Select/Deselect all
6. **Shift + D:** Duplicate selected object(s)
7. **Ctrl + S:** Save your project
8. **Ctrl + Z:** Undo
9. **Ctrl + Shift + Z:** Redo
10. **Tab:** Toggle between Object and Edit mode
11. **Ctrl + Tab:** Switch between Vertex, Edge, and Face select modes in Edit mode or use 1/2/3 buttons in the number row in the top bar of the keyboard in Edit Mode.

Viewport Navigation Hotkeys & Shortcuts in Blender:

12. **Middle Mouse Button (MMB) or Mouse Wheel:** Orbit the view
13. **Shift + MMB or Wheel:** Pan the view
14. **Ctrl + MMB or Wheel:** Zoom in/out
15. **Numpad 1, 3, 7:** View from the front, side, or top, respectively
16. **Numpad 5:** Toggle between Orthographic and Perspective view

Object Manipulation hotkeys & short keys in Blender:

17. **Ctrl + A:** Apply transformation (scale, rotation, location)
18. **Ctrl + G:** Create a new group
19. **Ctrl + P:** Parent objects
20. **Alt + P:** Clear parent
21. **Ctrl + J:** Join selected objects into one

Editing Meshes (in Edit Mode) hotkeys & shortcuts in Blender:

22. **E:** Extrude
23. **F:** Create a face/Make an edge into a face
24. **Ctrl + R:** Add Loop Cut
25. **K:** Activate the Knife Tool
26. **Ctrl + B:** Bevel
27. **W:** Specials menu (various operations)
28. **Ctrl + E:** Edges menu (context-sensitive)

Rendering and Shading hotkeys and shortcuts in Blender:

29. **F12:** Render image
30. **Shift + Z:** Toggle Rendered/Viewport Shading mode
31. **Z:** Open the shading pie menu (for selecting different shading modes)
32. **Shift + S:** Snap menu (for snapping objects)
33. **Shift + Z:** Toggle Rendered/Viewport Shading mode

Animation hotkeys & shortcuts in Blender:

34. **I:** Insert a keyframe
35. **Alt + A:** Play animation in the 3D view
36. **Spacebar:** Play/Pause animation
37. **Alt + R:** Clear rotation keyframes
38. **Alt + G:** Clear location keyframes

Texturing and UV Mapping hotkeys & Shortcuts in Blender:

39. **U:** Unwrap UVs
40. **T:** Open the Tool Shelf (useful for UV editing)

These are just some of the most commonly used Blender shortcuts and hotkeys. Blender has a vast number of features, so it's essential to explore its documentation and experiment with these shortcuts to become more proficient in using the software.
